



INTERNATIONAL 12 FOOT & DUBLIN BAY 12 FOOT IRISH CHAMPIONSHIPS 2016

28 August 2016.

1. RULES

- 2. The organising authority is the Royal St. George Yacht Club.
- Racing will be governed by the rules as defined by the 'Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016', The International 12 Foot Class rules, and the Dublin Bay 12 Foot rig and hull amendments.
- 4. International 12 Foots and DBSC 12 Foots will race together. No handicap system will apply.
- 5. Each boat may be crewed by one or two people.
- 6. Racing will take place in Dun Laoghaire harbour, or in the area immediately outside the harbour.
- In the event of winds exceeding 15 knots, racing will be postponed or abandoned.

T1 Start-123-Finish T2 Start-123-13-Finish T3 Start-123-13-123-Finish T4 Start-123-13-123-13-Finish T5 Start-123-13-123-13-123-Finish

- 21. The number of laps will be indicated on a board on the committee boat.
- 22. Layout of courses and numbers of marks:



23. START

- 24. Races will be started using Rule 26 with warning signal 3 minutes before the start, preparatory signal will be 2 minutes before the start, preparatory flag will be removed one minute before the start.
- 25. In the event of several classes competing, the 12 foots will start 3 minutes after the Fireball Class start.
- 26. The description of committee boats will be given at the briefing.
- 27. The start line will be between the main mast or a striped pole on the committee boat and a start mark.





28. FINISH

29. The finish line will be between the main mast or a striped pole on the committee boat and a finish mark.

30. PENALTY SYSTEM

31. Racing Rules 44.1 and 44.2 shall be modified to permit one turn including a tack and a gybe in the event of a boat breaking RRS Part 2 rules while racing.

32. TIME LIMIT

33. Time limit for each race will be 90 minutes. It is envisaged that most morning races will be 30-40 minutes duration.

34. PROTESTS

- 35. Protests will not be heard on the day of the event.
- 36. Protests will be heard by DBSC protest committee.
- 37. Competitors intending to protest must verbally advise the committee boat and receive an acknowledgement from same.

38. SCORING

- 39. The low points scoring system of Appendix 'A' will be used.
- **40. PRIZES**
- 41. Prizes will be awarded after racing.
