## – NOTICE OF RACE –

### 1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing. The sailing instructions for inshore races are common to all three waterfront regattas and will be circulated under the banner of the Dun Laoghaire Combined Clubs. The sailing instructions for offshore races are provided by ISORA.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Yachts in the following classes shall be eligible to enter and the schedule of racing shall be as indicated below:

The declaration on the form must be completed by the boat owner or his/her authorised representative and, if the owner is under 18 years of age, by his/her parent or guardian.

Entries close at 22:00 on Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2016. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Committee and only on payment of a €15 late entry fee.

## 4. HANDICAPS and DIVISION of CLASSES

Fleets will be divided on the following basis (subject to the committee's right to allocate a boat to any class):

Boats in other Cruiser Classes will be divided on the basis of their ISA Standard ECHO Reference Handicap.

### Class TCF Range

Cruisers Class 0 1.045 and above

Cruisers Class 1 0.980 to 1.044

Cruisers Class 2 0.920 to 0.979

Cruisers Class 3 0.820 to 0.919

Boats with ratings lower than minimum rating of the class above them may participate in that class but such boats shall accept the minimum rating of that class.

## 5. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## 6. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of €1,500,000 per event or the equivalent.

## 7. PRIZES

Prizes shall be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd overall in all classes, subject respectively to a minimum of 2, 5 or 7 entries in a class. Prize giving will take place at approximately 18.00 at the Royal St. George Yacht Club on the day of the regatta.

## 8. ASHORE

All Owners, Skippers and Crew will be Honorary Members of the RSGYC on the day of the Regatta. This privilege may be withdrawn at the discretion of the committee.

Prize giving will take place in the main bar or top deck at approximately 18.00

There will be a barbecue (outside, weather permitting), and entertainment, after sailing.
