

# NOTICE OF RACE

## Royal St. George Yacht Club International 12 Ft Dinghy Class & Dublin Bay 12 footer Irish Championships Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> August 2016

### 1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016, the ISA prescriptions.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

Entry is open to all International 12 Ft Class Dinghies, and Dublin Bay 12 footers.

Entries will be accepted on the day of the regatta subject to the owner advising the organizing committee of your intention to compete.

### 4. SCHEDULE AND RACING FORMAT

Competitor's briefing will be at 11.00 hrs. on Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> August.

#### Starts

A maximum of 4 races are scheduled over one day. Details of race formats, start times and courses will be available (subject to weather) at registration.



### 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AND SCORING

Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

One race is required to be completed to constitute a series and there will be one discard if four races have been completed. Prizes will be the Seapoint Trophy and the Cora Cup which are the 12 Foot Irish National Championship prizes.

### 6. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in this regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS Rule 4 – Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during or after the regatta.

### 7. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of €2,000,000 for any one accident.

### 8. OTHER INFORMATION

Entrants and authorised guests are temporary members of Royal St. George Yacht Club during the period of the event.
