Change to Regatta Sailing Instructions

Amendment No. 1 to SI "6 Handicaps and division of Classes"

SI 6.3 shall now read:

6.3 White-Sail Cruisers shall conform to DBSC class requirements. Other cruiser classes will be divided as follows on the basis of their ISA standard Echo Reference Handicap or IRC Handicap (subject to the Regatta Committee's right to allocate a boat to any class):

	ECHO Reference Handicap (TCF)
Cruiser Class 0	1.035 and above
Cruiser Class 1	0.980 to 1.034
Cruiser Class 2	0.920 to 0.979 and boats with a LOA greater than 9m and TCF 0.905 to 0.979
Cruiser Class 3	0.820 to 0.919

Amendment No. 2 to SI "10 Start"

SI 10.1 and 10.2 shall now read:

10.1 Boats starting on Schedules A, B, and C will start as per RRS 26. The class flag of the succeeding class may be displayed at the starting signal of the preceding class.

10.2 For boat racing on courses Schedule A and B the Starting line will be between the candy stripped pole on the Race Committee Vessel, displaying the burgee of the yacht club and the course identification flag and the starting limit mark.

For boats racing on Schedule C the Starting line will be between the "Orange Pole" on the Race Committee Vessel, displaying the burgee of the yacht club and the course identification flag and the starting limit mark.

Amendment No. 3 to SI "13 Finish"

13 For boats racing on Schedule A and B the finishing line will be between the candy stripped pole on a Race Committee Vessel, displaying a blue flag and the course identification flag, and the finishing mark.

For schedule C the finishing line will be between the “Orange Pole” on a Race Committee Vessel, displaying a blue flag and the course identification flag, and the finishing mark.

Amendment No 4. Addition of SI “19 Shortening the Course”

19.1 The course may be shortened in accordance with RRS 32. The finish would then be between a mark of the course and a vessel displaying flag S (and a class flag if appropriate).

19.2 The course may be shortened using flag V (and a class flag if appropriate), displayed near a mark of the course. In this case, boats shall round that mark as normal, but then proceed directly to the normal finish line, crossing the line in the direction from the mark where flag V was displayed. This changes RRS 32.2.

Amendment No. 5 to Schedule A “3. Starting and Finishing Lines”

SI 3 shall now read:

3.1 The race shall start approximately North to North East of Dun Laoghaire Harbour

3.2 The Race Committee boat will be located approximately to windward of the last mark of the course and will be displaying a red identification flag. The finish will be between the main mast of the Committee vessel and a mark with flag on a pole. Note The finish line will be on the opposite side of the vessel to the start line as per diagram below.
