SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

To be read in conjunction with the Standard Sailing Instructions for Irish Provincial Championships.

The notation [NP] in a rule of the sailing instructions means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located online at the Virtual Race Office- click here: and via the event WhatsApp Group.

2. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

Signals made ashore will be displayed at the flagpole on the RSGYC Forecourt and also the event Whatsapp group.

3. COURSES

A Trapezoid course shall be used. The diagrams in Attachment A show the courses, including the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left.

4. MARKS

Marks 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 will be black inflatable marks. The start mark will be a dan buoy with an orange Flag. The finish mark will be a dan buoy with a blue Flag.

5. AREAS THAT ARE OBSTRUCTIONS

Tender vessels for a cruise liner in the bay may be in operation in the vicinity of the harbour. Competitors should stay clear and obey instructions of escorting ribs while leaving and coming ashore.

6. HEARING REQUESTS

Should be made via the Virtual Race Office on the club website.

7. OFFICIAL VESSELS

The Committee Vessel will be a white hulled sailboat, called Terra Nova, identifiable with an Orange flag flying.

8. LAUNCHING AREAS

As space is limited in the Royal St George boats that are normally based in Dun Laoghaire must launch from their home area. Visitors from outside Dun Laoghaire may park and launch from the RSGYC.


9. RACE AREA

The Race area shall be to the North West or North East of Dun Laoghaire Harbour. DBSC????.

10. TALLY SYSTEM

A tally system will operate for sailors launching from the Royal St George Yacht club, with sail numbers being noted. Boats launching from other areas of the harbor will be escorted in and out by safety ribs. Any boat retiring to shore early should notify a safety vessel.
